About CancerCare

CancerCare is a unique independent charity dedicated to helping North Lancashire & South Lakeland families affected by cancer and other life limiting conditions.

About the service

CancerCare provide a wide range of free professional therapy services. These are designed to help individuals and their families come to terms with and manage the challenges of a serious health condition.

CancerCare has two dedicated centres based in **Kendal** (The Lakes Centre, Blackhall Road) and in **Lancaster** (Slynedales, Slyne Road) and also provides outreach services in local hospitals and community outlets.

Funding

All CancerCare services are made possible through fundraising and generous donations from local people.

Volunteers

Volunteering with CancerCare can be a great way to make new friends, gain new experiences and give something back to the local community.

If you can spare an hour or two each week, each fortnight or even a few times a year we want to hear from you. We welcome people with a whole range of skills and abilities. No experience is necessary and training and support is offered. Volunteers need to be 18+.

- advertise the services that we offer
- raise money to deliver the services that we offer
- provide nice surroundings for people to receive services
- transport clients that are too poorly to drive to one of our centres.

- keep in contact with us and let us know of any change in circumstances affecting your volunteering.

- an identified manager who will provide you with support and guidance and will keep in regular contact

- the opportunity to change or take on additional roles.

What you can do?
